JUNIORS

Junior competitions have for the past two years been conducted every two weeks in Term time. Typically in Terms 1 and 4 we meet on Saturday mornings. Tee off from 8.30 a.m. and in Terms 2 and 3 we meet on Sunday afternoons. Tee off from 3:00 p.m. Actual dates are confirmed during the preceding week via email and on the Gin Gin Golf Facebook page.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Match Committee is in charge of all play on the course and reserves the right to alter the programme or method of play at any time. They also confer if any complaints or issues arise over a specific competition or a players conduct, etc.
2. All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the Club's By-laws and Local Rules.
3. A protest or dispute in connection with any competition or match shall be made, preferably in writing to the Match Committee immediately upon completion of play in such competition or match. Decisions by the Match Committee will be Final.
4. A member may invite a guest to participate in the Club Competition in his company at the appropriate fee.
5. Payment of fees deems acceptance of the conditions of play.

COURSE RULES

1. Sand buckets are provided, and players are requested to use same at all times to help maintain fairways in good order.
2. Help keep the course tidy. Receptacles are provided. Please use them.
3. Preserve tees. Do not have unnecessary practice swings.
4. Do not practice from tees or fairways or onto a green. The practice green and practice fairway are located adjacent to the Clubhouse.

ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF

1. When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the putting green.
2. **No one should stand close to or directly behind the ball, move or talk when a player is making a stroke. On the putting green, no one should stand beyond the hole on the line of a player's stroke.**
3. No player should play from the tee until those in the group in front have played their second shots
4. In the interest of all, players should PLAY WITHOUT UNDUE DELAY. Walk briskly between shots, keep up with the players in front. Players who have the honour should have their tee

shot before making cards and remember, your slowness is extremely irritating to those players behind you.

5. Players searching for a ball should allow other players coming up to pass them; they should signal to the players following to pass and should not continue their play until those players have passed out of range.
6. Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully rake the area of the bunker used and the rake should be placed in the bunker. (We currently have no bunkers!)
7. Through the green; Players should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by them is replaced at once and covered with sand. Any damage to the putting green made by the ball or player is to be carefully repaired.
8. Players should ensure that, when dropping their bag or the flag-stick, no damage is done to the green and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to the hole or in handling the flag-stick, nor stick the flag-stick in the greens. The flag-stick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green.
9. LOSS OF POSITION: If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on those players in front, it should invite the match following to pass.

HANDICAP IN USE FOR VARIOUS EVENTS

It is the players' responsibility to ensure that after they have completed their round, their hole by hole score is entered either by using the MiScore app on their phone or entering their scores via the Kiosk Screen on the Captains Desk in the Clubhouse.

The exception to this is Ambrose events – for these events please just hand your card to the Club Captain or place in the Score card box.

NEW FOR 2026:

As we continue to seek ways to make our competitions more enjoyable and interesting we may have more changes to come. One of the significant changes to the local rules in 2025 was that placing on the fairway being played was changed from a card length to a club length. This change will remain in force for the foreseeable future.

The first change for the 2026 season is that all "two's" (2's) whether scored on a Par 3, 4 or 5 will receive a golf ball. Please mark the score appropriately on the card or if using MiScore plus notify the Club Captain.

SPECIFIC COMPETITIONS

POHLMAN MATCHPLAY - MEN:

The Captain will calculate the aggregate of each members' **best 8 single stroke (nett) results** from the previous playing season (1st February to 31st January) from Weekend events at the Gin Gin Course.

The best 8 results are seeded to play handicap match play. Handicaps shall be as at 1st February and do not change during the event. In the event of a squared match, the players will play sudden death, except in the final where they will play a further 18 holes. If the match still remains square, they then play sudden death. All matches to be played on or before the date set down.

COMBINED CHAMPIONSHIPS

Played as a team format over 4 different team's events. The team will consist of the same pairing for each of the four rounds. **However, due to the challenge of both members being available on the set dates, teams may play on the adjacent Sunday provided they have a marker with them.**

The events are **American Foursomes, 4B Aggregate Stroke, 4BBB Stableford and Ambrose.**

The aggregate net score from each event is totalled and the team with the lowest aggregate **NETT score** will be the Championship winners.

There will be **NO GROSS winner in 2026.**

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS SINGLES HANDICAP MATCHPLAY:

A random draw of 32 will be created. The handicaps used will always be the player AGU handicap on the day of the match. In the event of a squared match, the players will play sudden death. The knockout matches will need to be played within a one month deadline in which the players can arrange to play the match at any time. The final date for completion will be on the Monthly Medal day (typically the 2nd Saturday of the month). The draw will be published in February and the first round matches will need to be completed by the 17th April (extenuating circumstances not withstanding). All subsequent matches will be played in each of the following months with the Final played on or before the 8th August. Any date changes are at the discretion of the Club Captain and Match Committee.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS TEAM HANDICAP MATCHPLAY: - NEW EVENT IN 2026

A draw of up to 16 pairs will be created. Players are to choose their own partners and submit their names to the Club Captain by the end of June. As per the Singles Matchplay, each round is to be completed on or before the month's Monthly Medal. The random draw will be published by the 4th July with Round 1 to be completed by the Monthly Medal in August (8th August). Round 2 (8 teams) by the Monthly Medal in September (12th Sept.), Round 3 by the Monthly Medal in October (10th Oct.) and the Final on or before the Monthly Medal in November (14th Nov).

ECLECTIC AND PUTTING AVERAGE

These events are conducted on Monthly Medal Days. *A player must compete in at least 6 of the 12 events to qualify.*

PATRONS TROPHY: MEN AND LADIES

This event is conducted over 6 rounds (2 Stroke, 2 Stableford, and 2 Bogey) with 4 rounds to count. Rounds are conducted from March to September.

The winning score on each day will score 10 points with a diminishing points table for each stroke difference. ie.

In the event of a tie, the worst points score shall be dropped until a winner is determined.

ORDER OF MERIT

Points will be awarded on Single event days.

APPENDIX:

LOCAL RULES

Local rules are to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf.

Before commencing play, competitors should check the competition notice board for details of local rules that may be temporarily in place. Local Rules are displayed on the board at the Clubhouse.

Out of bounds is defined by all boundary fences and where there is no fence white stakes with a black top define out of bounds.

Local Rule F-8

"Cracks in the ground are ground under repair. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. *[But relief is not allowed if the crack only interferes with the player's stance.]*

Local Rule F-9

"If a player's ball lies in the general area of the course and there is interference from exposed tree roots, the tree roots are treated as ground under repair. The player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b. *[But relief is not allowed if the tree roots only interfere with the player's stance.]*

Local Rule F-11

Ant Hills: Ant hills are loose impediments and may be removed under Rule 15.1. They are not animal holes from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. But there are situations when ant hills are difficult or impossible to remove (such as when large, hard or conical in shape).

"Ant hills on the course are, at the player's option, loose impediments that may be removed under Rule 15.1 or ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1."

Local Rule F-17

"All cart paths on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

Bare Patches:

Any bare patches on the fairway are considered abnormal ground conditions, allowing for free relief under Rule 16.1b.

Tree surrounds:

Full relief may be taken from the immediate area around a scrub or tree that is bare ground. However, you must not improve your line of sight in doing so. *Thus, if the tree is in line between your ball and the flag, you must take relief behind the tree so that the tree is still in line with the flag.*

Green Keepers Shed and Cart Shed:

The Greenkeepers Shed is no longer an 'out of bounds' area. Instead, on the 2nd and 11th holes, if your ball is behind the greenkeepers shed or cart shed or the area between them, such that you do not have direct line of sight to the green, you MUST take a free drop on the fairway within two club lengths of the ball's line of entry into this area.
